



Eleven Plus Maths How To Do - Time - The Four Rules -
 Multiplication

60 seconds = 1 minute

60 minutes = 1 hour

(1) Example: 2 hrs 35 mins x 6

Put the headings:-

hr	mins	
2	35	
x	6	
15	30	
3	210	

Multiply the minutes. If the answer is 59 or more then put the answer below the answer line and divide by 60 to change minutes to hours.

$$210 \div 60 = 3 \text{ hrs } 30 \text{ min.}$$

Carry the 3 hrs to the hour column and put the 3 under the answer line.

Multiply 2 by 6 = 12 Add the 3 hours 12 + 3 = 15

(2) 6 mins 38 sec x 7

mins	sec	
6	38	
	7	
46	26	
4	266	

$$266 \text{ secs} \div 60 = 4 \text{ mins } 26 \text{ sec}$$
