	E / C * B = ()
HOW TO DO IT	
	Put the right numbers where the letters are to form an equation. Answer the equation with the letter that corresponds to your answer.
HINT	
	Replace each letter with the correct number first, then do the equation, remembering that * means multiply and / means divide. Remember to replace the numerical answer you get with the right letter! e.g. If A=3, B=5, C=6, D=10, E=15, what is the answer to B*C/A = —— It becomes 5*6/3 = 10 which is D
