







Eleven Plus Verbal Reasoning Worksheet - USING NUMBERS FOR LETTERS

<u>QUESTION</u>	
	If A=75, B=5, C=10, D=50, E=150, what is the answer to the sum: $E / C * B = (\quad)$
<u>HOW TO DO IT</u>	
	Put the right numbers where the letters are to form an equation. Answer the equation with the letter that corresponds to your answer.
<u>HINT</u>	
	Replace each letter with the correct number first, then do the equation, remembering that * means multiply and / means divide. Remember to replace the numerical answer you get with the right letter! e.g. If A=3, B=5, C=6, D=10, E=15, what is the answer to $B*C/A =$ _____ It becomes $5*6/3 = 10$ which is D
