







Eleven Plus Verbal Reasoning Worksheet - WORD CONNECTIONS

<u>QUESTION</u>	
	<p>In the following question there is the SAME connection between the word outside each set of brackets and one word inside each set of brackets. You must find this same connection and then write out the TWO words.</p> <p>Flower is to (garden, water, pollen) as wheat is to (cereal, barley, field)</p>
<u>HOW TO DO IT</u>	
	<p>There is the same connection between the words outside each set of brackets and one of the words from inside each set of brackets. Choose one word from each set of brackets to complete the sentence in the best way.</p>
<u>HINT</u>	
	<p>They may be opposites, have a similar meaning or be a natural pair. First decide what type of connection there could be in the first part of the sentence, then look at the second part of the sentence.</p> <p>e.g. laugh is to (cry, chuckle, grin) as tall is to (tree, wide, short).</p> <p>Cry is opposite to laugh and Short is opposite to tall.</p>
