

Eleven Plus Maths How To Do - Subtraction of Decimals

You set the sum out just as you did for addition, first putting in the decimal points and then filling in the figures.

Example: 26.7 - 9.38

 26.70	(The nought we have put in the top line has
9.38	not changed the value of the number, but it
	helps to keep the figures in their correct
	places).
