


## <u>Eleven Plus Maths How To Do - Time - The Four Rules -</u> <u>Addition</u>

60 seconds = 1 minute 60 minutes = 1 hour

You have been used to working in units of 10, but now you have to remember to work in units of 60 when working in hours, minutes or seconds.

(1) Example: 2 hrs 45 min + 3 hrs 46mins.



Convert the 91 mins to hrs by dividing by 60

91 ÷ 60 = 1 hrs 31 min

Put the small 1 under the answer in the hours column, and then add.

(2) Example: 2 hrs 25 min 54 sec + 1 hr 50 min 24 sec

+	hrs 2 1	min 25 50	sec 54 24

78 sec = 1 min 18 sec

76 min = 1 hr 16 min.
