







Eleven Plus Verbal Reasoning Worksheet - MAKING ONE WORD FROM TWO

<u>QUESTION</u>	
	<p>One word from each group will go together to make another proper word. The word from the first group starts the new word. Find the TWO words.</p> <p>Made/occur/blind bring/red/grey</p>
<u>HOW TO DO IT</u>	
	<p>Take one word from the first group and one from the second group and join them together to make a new word. (the word from the first group begins the new word.)</p>
<u>HINT</u>	
	<p>Try each word from the first group against each word from the second group until you find one that sounds right. Be careful as joining them together may change the way the words sound!</p> <p>e.g. (easy, relax, comfort) (full, can, able)</p> <p>Answer = comfortable</p>
<u>ANSWER</u>	
	<p>OCCUR, RED</p>
